#### The Town Council had considered the following Planning Applications:

a) Application No. 2025/0644/FUL

Cllr R. Smith had advised that the work is being done sympathetically and the 3 county councillors had been invited by the company to the church to review what the plans were.

Cllr J Bowen would like to put forward queries to the planning department for further information about the drainage issues. The design looks great but there are concerns on how drainage will be supplied. Application states no change to existing drainage, but there is no drainage?

Cllr C. Richards provided information on the company; Twiddleys, they produce flatbed jigs, blanks and bases that are used on digital UV printers, the building will be used for taking orders and keeping stock. Parking will be in Dock Street, query on whether this is an adopted road. Need to understand how many vehicles will be going in and out of that road. Are residents aware of the situation.

Cllr R. Smith – the issues raised were issues for the company to resolve but weren't necessarily planning issues.

Cllr Phillips – queried where and how they were digging, taking into consideration that the graveyard was in that area and as they would need to be digging to put in drainage there should be some thought given to the archaeological side of this.
